All students who attend the Harker English Language Institute must be serious about their education and understand the importance of maintaining our positive learning environment inside and outside of the classroom. Therefore, Harker's behavioral expectations are clear and concise. Please take note of the following:

- Sensitivity to others and mutual respect are basic expectations of all students who attend the Institute.
- Harassment, defined as behavior that is insulting, demeaning, distressful or intimidating, will be cause for dismissal.
- Students must be respectful of teachers and be dedicated to their studies.
- Deliberate attempt to disrupt teaching is cause for suspension and on a second offense will be cause for dismissal.
- In-class and homework assignments must be completed on time as instructed by the teachers.
- Physical aggression towards classmates or teachers will not be tolerated under any circumstances.
- Stealing and cheating are serious offenses and will be cause for suspension or dismissal.
- Proper treatment of The Harker School facilities is required at all times.
- Rules for use of outdoor equipment and supplies will be provided and should be respected by students.
- While off campus, students will follow field trip instructions and behave in a manner that represents the school positively.
- Bus rules and regulations must be followed to ensure student safety.
- Possession or use of illegal drugs, alcohol, or tobacco or weapons of any sort is unacceptable.

Dress Code

Students' dress should reflect pride in the person and the school. Our expectation is that all students should be well-groomed and appropriately attired at all times when on campus. Clothing should be appropriate, in good taste, in good repair and without extremes.

Parents/guardians will be contacted by the school if any of the above expectations are not being met by the student. The school expects that parents/guardians will join with the school to improve student behavior and to enforce any consequences that may be deemed appropriate.
