NON-HARKER STUDENTS:

Submit with application the following for any for-credit classes:

- Current Report Card
- Teacher Recommendation Form from subject area teacher. Form available in the registration and fees section on our website.

Non-Harker students applying for honors level math courses will be contacted about a required proficiency exam at the end of March.

DEPOSITS

Deposits are non-refundable/non-transferable and are required with the application.

Deposit amounts will be deducted from the program fees:

- All Courses: \$200
- (Full payment is due for Driver Education class)

PAYMENT OF TUITION BALANCES

The balance of fees is due on or before May 8, 2020. Statements will be mailed to the billing address listed on the application.

REFUND POLICY

After May 8, 2020, there will be no tuition refunds or tuition transfers. No adjustment of fees will be made if a student is withdrawn before the end of the period of enrollment, or is dismissed for conduct prejudicial to the discipline and or good name of the school.

ATTENDANCE POLICY

Attendance is mandatory in all for-credit classes. Students who miss:

- more than one class period of a three- or four- week course, OR
- more than two class periods of a six-week course

will be dropped from the class and will not be eligible for credit or refund.

Students may not audit a for-credit course.

NOTE: Friday, July 3 is a holiday. No classes will be held that day.

PROGRAM/CLASS CHANGES

Program and class changes will not be permitted after the start of the program. There are no tuition refunds resulting from program changes after May 8, 2020.
